However, in recent years there's been significant investment in the area to attract those seeking a better work-life balance, such as Wexford County Council's 'Hatch Lab', a dynamic technology business space offering hot desks and permanent office solutions.

Hotels in the area include the Ashdown Park and Amber Springs hotels both with leisure centres, while Marlfield House Hotel and Seafield Spa & Hotel resort are a short drive away. Nearby Courtown Harbour offers sailing and water sport activities and is also home to the Active Tribe adventure and leisure centre, a state-of-the-art swimming, gym, outdoor activity fitness and wellness facility. There are numerous fabulous beaches, nature & woodland walks all within a 10 min drive from the development.









Entertainment

Gorey has a wealth of Cafés, gastro-pubs, restaurants, and hotels to cater for every taste. The town also boasts many cultural amenities such as galleries, a cinema and library. The Gorey Little Theatre, a 330 seater state-of-the-art facility, hosts the annual South Leinster Drama Festival and a one act festival in which amateur drama groups from all over the country come to perform, along with a Christmas
